Ray Hatch was employed by Jurgens who were contracted to demolish part of the Methanol to Gasoline Plant for Methanex New Zealand Ltd.

The main components for removal were:

- 10 exchangers at 90t by 20 mtr long
- 7 heaters at 70t by 30 mtr high
- 6 reactors at 80t by 15 mtr high
- 2 level pipe bridge 110 mtr long by 10 mtr high

A total of 4000 ton was demolished and processed inside a scheduled 6 month period.

Ray's responsibilities included rigging, gas cutting, machine operation, supervision, training, planning and execution.
